

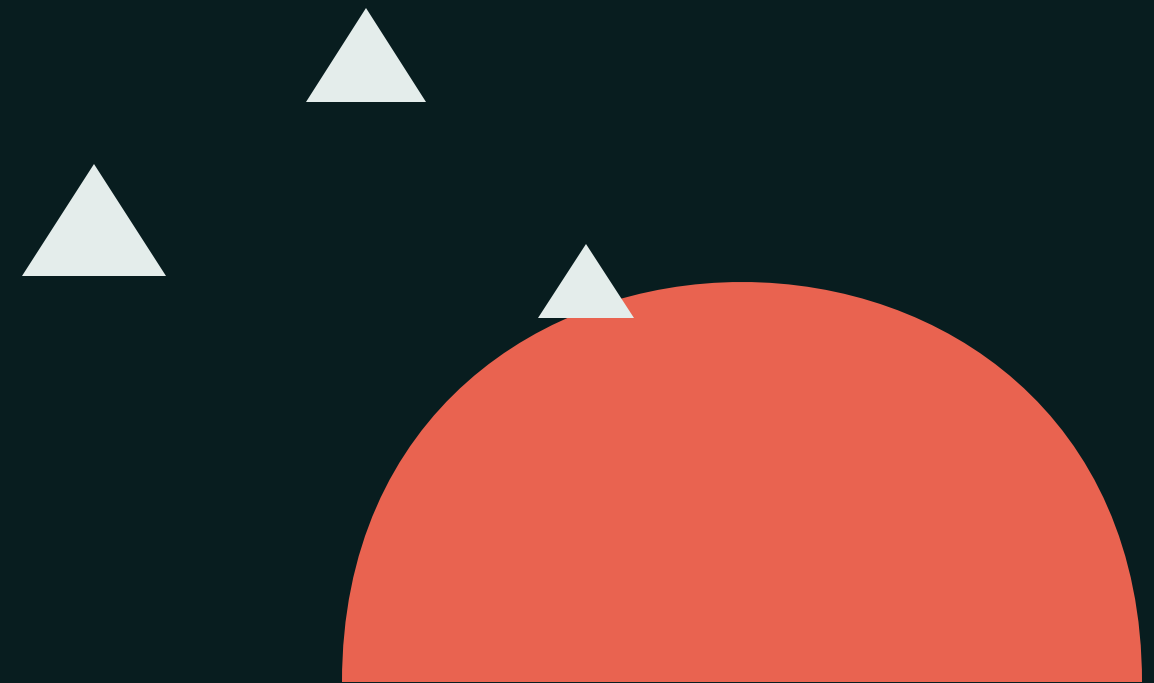

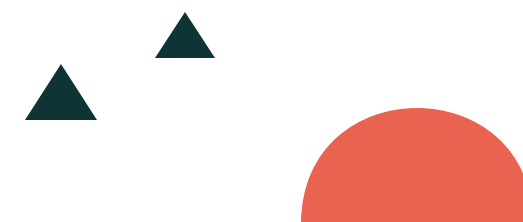


SECTION 01 · THE STATEMENT

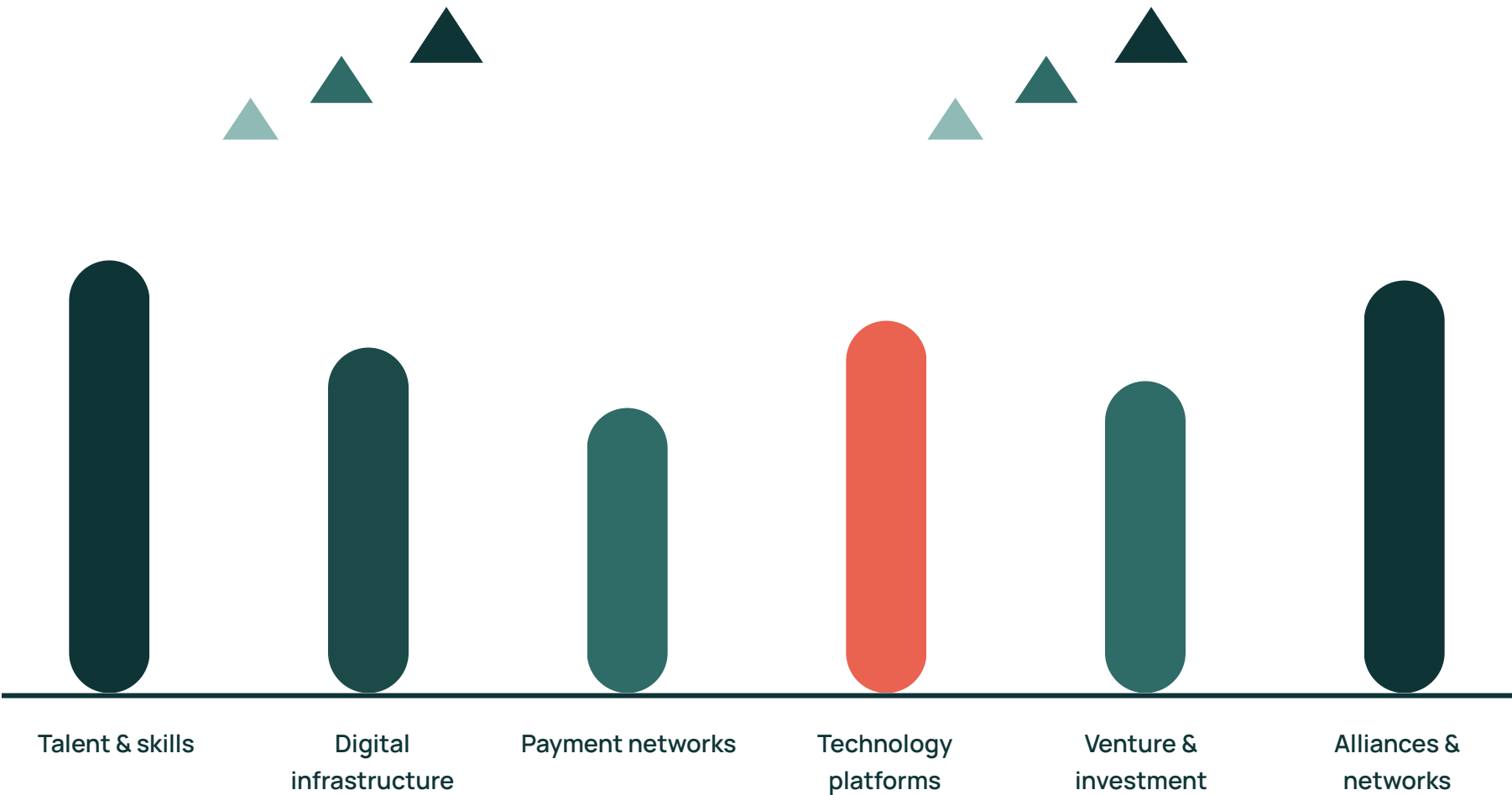

Africa’s trusted source of applied blockchain *skills*.

The blockchain practice builds capability the way economies actually adopt it: seven modules, from foundations to security audits, delivered blended and certified by ATT.



Seven audiences — from bankers and lawyers to developers and policymakers — each with a named outcome. ATT-certified credentials and a train-the-trainer track multiply every cohort. Economy-fit use cases connect the skills to the sectors where each economy actually earns.



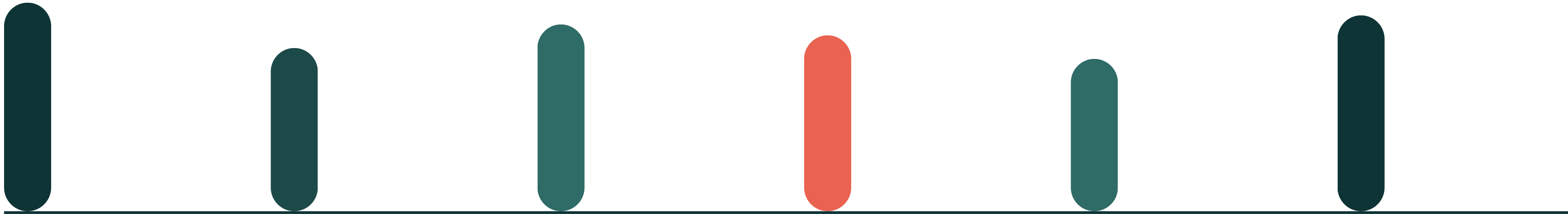


SECTION 07

Everything it takes to scale, built as one.

ATT is not a software vendor. It is an institution that builds platforms, operates them and answers for them – at continental scale.



Talent & Skills

The engineers, operators and leaders a technology economy runs on – developed through the Academy, seven training verticals and the ATT talent ladder.

Digital Infrastructure

Sovereign-grade cloud, data and connectivity foundations – architected with governments and delivered with operating partners across the continent.

Payment Networks

Interoperable payment and settlement rails – stablecoin and digital-payment capability engineered with regulators and market operators.

Technology Platforms

Platforms ATT builds, operates and stands behind – engineered by the practices, run as continental infrastructure, announced as they ship.

Venture & Investment

Incubation, seed capital and aligned institutional investment – founders backed on non-extractive terms, capital deployed to the mandate.

Alliances & Networks

Governments, corporates, academia, hubs and the diaspora – one table, aligned to deliver, engaged MoU by MoU.



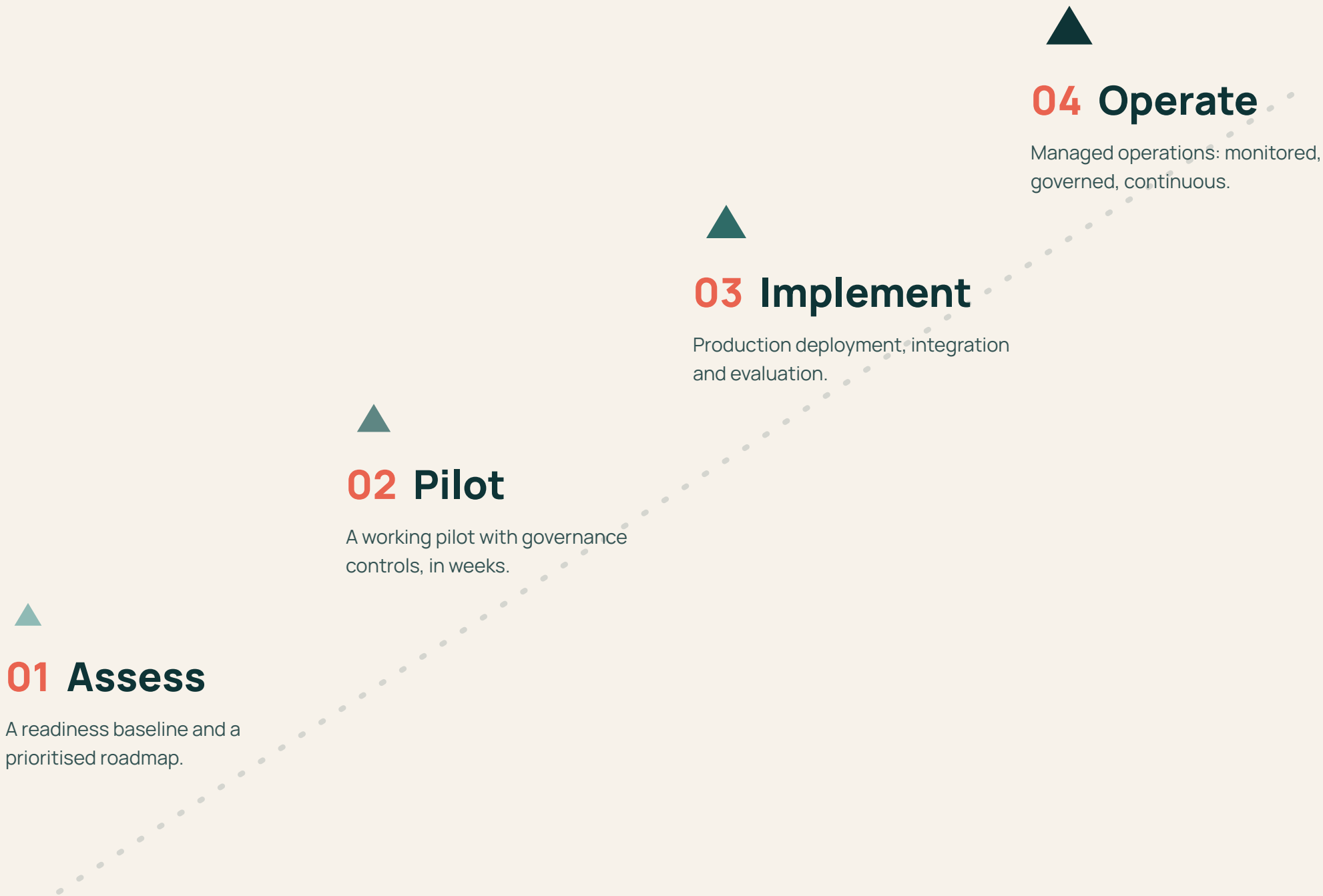


SECTION 08

Caribbean & Brazil – expertise, capital and market access in both directions.



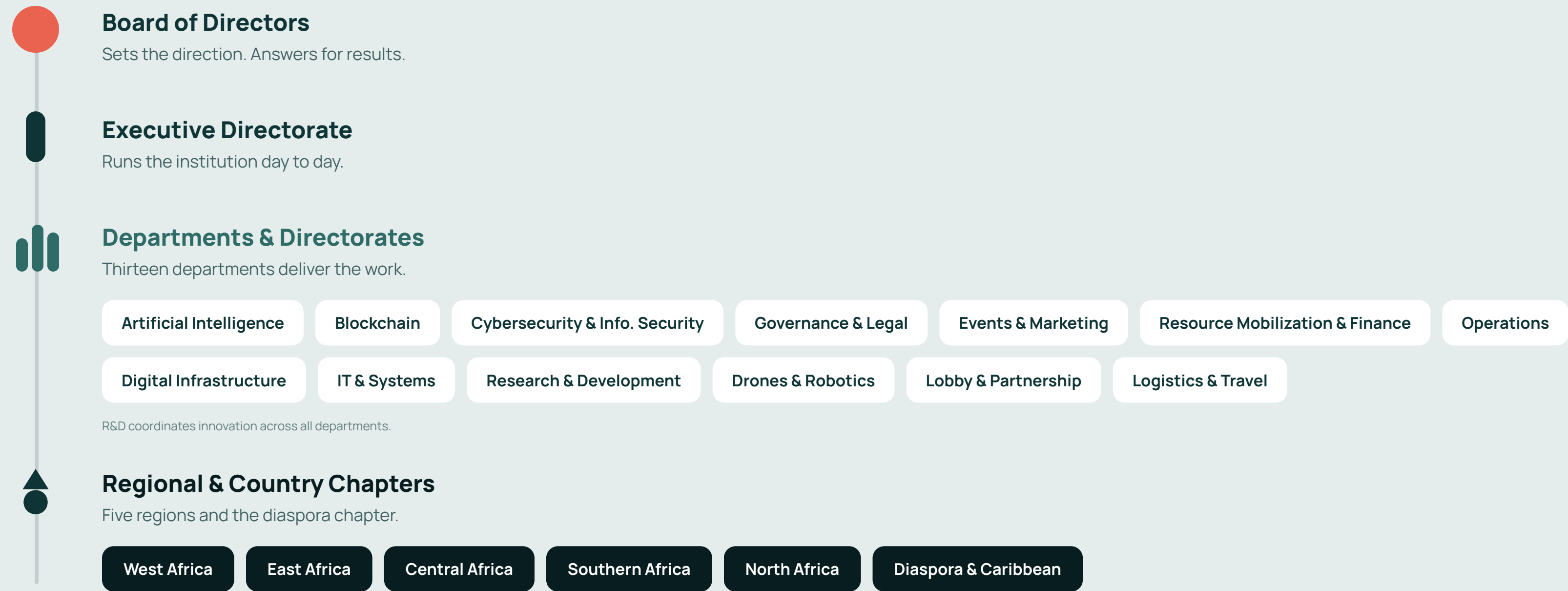


SECTION 10
